## YEAR OF ST. PAUL

*What does Paul teach about reconciliation?*

Paul has a profound understanding of reconciliation. He directly ties the reconciliation of God to the salvation that God has wrought in Christ. Second Corinthians contains the most extended reference to Paul's view.

So if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation: everything old has passed away; see, everything has become new! All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation; that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting the message of reconciliation to us. So we are ambassadors for Christ, since God is making his appeal through us; we entreat you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God. (2 Cor. 5:17-20)

One thing to notice is the tension between the "already", the sense that God has already reconciled us through Christ, and the "not yet": now be reconciled to God. Paul does not see this tension as an internal contradiction. Reconciliation is a grace-filled action of God toward all humanity. It is also a part of the ongoing ministry of Christians in relationship to themselves and others.

Disputes, disagreements, or breaches of trust are never so hopeless that reconciliation is impossible.

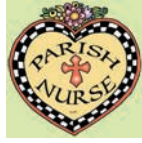
## God's Call to Love and Respect Others
