Catholic Life: This course will give an overview of what it means to be a Catholic in today's world. It is designed to help students examine some core beliefs, practices and attitudes to foster an understanding of what it means to be Catholic.

Justice and Service: Students will be introduced to issues of justice, direct service and advocacy. The seven principles of Catholic Social teaching will be explored including; The Sanctity of Human Life and Dignity of the Human Person, The Call to Live as Family and Community, Rights and Responsibilities, Preferential Option for the Poor and Vulnerable, The Dignity of Work and the Rights of Workers and Solidarity, and Care for God's Creation.

Sports and Spirituality: Sports have long been used as a metaphor for life. Its lessons are simple – never give up, try your best and play fair. The reward of participating in sports comes not from winning the medal or having the fastest time, but from the wonderful connection of spirit, soul and body that gives glory to our Creator through our every action. This course will give students an understanding of how faith fits into the spiritual nature of play, games, and sport.
